- ◇ Lidocaine Epidurals
- ◇ Listening to rumen contractions
- ◇ Discussion on minerals, nutrition, and resources
- ◇ Proper preparation, taking, and handling of samples (blood, feces and others).
- ◇ How to notice, evaluate, and treat a sick sheep
- ◇ Discussion of problem solving techniques for diagnosis of disease or other conditions
- ◇ Herd health
- ◇ Drugs and dosages used in sheep
